### **School Charges 2008**

#### Principles

- cost neutral (no profit/ no loss across all events each year)
  - no pay, no go
- some payments/ part payments are non refundable (these will be identified prior)
- money collection will allow at least 3 weeks for payment; with facilities for lay-by and forward/ credit payments
- with Principals approval, school will provide confidential support to families in difficult financial circumstances

Office payments are only accepted on Fridays from 8- 9:30am.

#### **1. Resource Lists (Prep to 7)**

Each year teachers set a minimum Resource List of essential items for all students in each year level. Additional resources may be required through the year. Parents may purchase the items

- from any supplier(s); or
- as a package on line (including delivery); or
- (from 2009) through the school Resource Scheme
  - Prep \$? per child
  - Year 1-3 \$? per child
  - Year 4-7 \$? per child

#### **2. Instrumental Music**

### **P+C Voluntary Contribution 2008**
